Procurement of Back Garage Gate (Vehicle and Pedestrian) with Automatic Gate Mechanism

Terms of Reference

The Embassy of the Philippines ("Embassy") intends to engage the services of a Company ("Company") specializing on gate construction and installation with automatic gate system for the back garage parking area of the Chancery.

I. Background

The back gate (for vehicle access) with automatic gate mechanism was constructed and installed on 2017. However, due to the weight of the gate, it was reported that the automatic gate system has occasionally failed, especially during the cold season.

However, on March 2022, the automatic gate system is no longer functioning despite several efforts to repair it. Since then, the magnetic lock was disengaged in order to allow manual opening and closing of the gate in the meantime. Nonetheless, due to the weight of the gate, the manual movement of the gate is not sustainable in the long run as the gate is increasingly wearing down due to constant forceful movement of the gate which results to occasional de-railing of the gate from its alignment.

II. Scope of Work

The Company shall be in charge of removing and disposing of existing gate (pedestrian and vehicle) and its parts, including the automatic gate system, and replace it with a complete set of new gates for pedestrian and vehicles with automatic gate system.

III. Approved Budget for the Contract

The Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) is Twenty-Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Won (KRW 23,500,000), inclusive of all applicable fees and taxes.

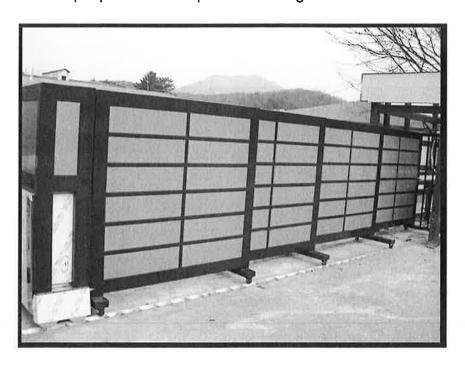

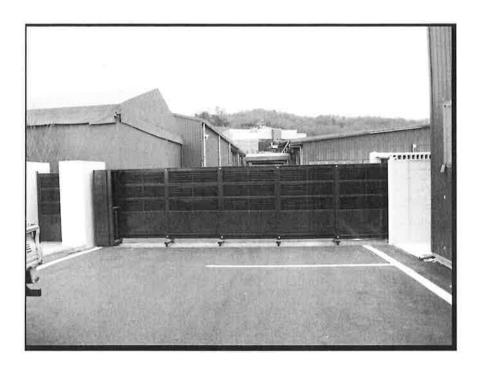
